

Access Statement For Whitehill Country Park

Introduction

Whitehill Country Park is located in an area called Stoke Gabriel set in 25 acres. We strive to ensure that all visitors can enjoy the accommodation, facilities and surroundings within the park. Our aim is to help in anyway that we can and if you require assistance during your stay or whilst planning your visit we will be delighted to assist. Our current facilities and services offered are:

Pre-Arrival

- We cater for tents, touring caravans, motorhomes and have holiday caravans for hire and lodges for sale.
- Our brochure is available in large print and we can post a copy of this access statement if required.
- We offer fax, email, textphone and staff always accept Type Talk calls.
- Our nearest town is Paignton located 2 miles away which has a train and bus station, with a taxi rank.
- The public bus transport stop is located outside our park.
- Our nearest shop mobility is Victoria Car Park. Garfield Road. Paignton. Tel: 01803 521771 also Pluss Organisation Ltd. Waddeton Close. Brixham Road. Paignton. Tel: 01803 520386.
- The local taxis company that has wheelchair access transport – Tel: 01803 211611 also 01803 213213 – both companies require notice.

Arrival & Car Parking Facilities

- As you drive into our main entrance you enter our car park. A contact telephone number for the park and for assistance is located to the left on the outside of a shed.
- The car park and roadway leading to reception is tarmac.
 - We have a two disabled allocated parking spaces near to reception. They are approximately 8 meters away from reception with a few benches for resting places along the way.
 - On entering reception there is a call button in Braille to ask for assistance to enter reception if required. The doors are double doors with a width of 1.7 meters.

Main Entrance & Reception

- In the reception there is ample room for a large wheelchair to manoeuvre and turn. The door way is 81cm wide.
- The reception has a pad and pen on the counter. The counter is 96cm high, but we also have a coffee table to use which is 71cm high.

- The opening times of reception are displayed on the door along with 24-hour contact details.
- A number of our staff have attended a number of Welcome courses to include `Welcome All` .

Public Areas - General (Internal)

- Tarmac roads service all parts of the park with the occasional speed ramp located in our touring section. There are grass areas either side of the ramps to allow for wheelchairs, pushchairs etc.
- The Park is hilly but all the main facilities are in a flat area.
- There are benches located around the park.

Public Areas - WC

- The Park has two toilet blocks servicing the touring section with a parking bay outside of each.
- Each of our other facilities has adequate shower and WC facilities where appropriate.
- For more information on touring facilities please refer to touring section.

Take Away / Café and Bars

- The café / takeaway and bars have accessible parking bays approximately 10 meters away from the main doors of each facility.
- There are double doors opening into the café/takeaway @ 1.6 meters wide when both doors are opened. This facility is accessed by one step.
- The Hayloft bar and Granary disco is located on the 1st floor and accessible by stairs and also a ramp which is 139cm wide
- Tables and chairs can be accommodated on request to accommodate wheelchairs.
- The bar also has an outside terrace which is accessed by the same ramp.
- All public areas are non-smoking.
- This area has a disabled access toilet with grab rails and low level basin. This is located on the ground floor below the arcade.

Laundry

- The laundry has parking bays approximately 10 meters away.
- It has level access throughout with a door width of 1.23 meters
- All washing machines are top loading.
- All ironing boards can be height adjusted and the switch can be reached from the sitting position.
- There is tables and seating.

Shop

- Accessed by a paved and cobbled area by wide doors.

- There is a parking bay approximately 10 meters away the shop.
- The shop is on one level.
- There is ample room within for a large wheelchair to manoeuvre & turn.
- The counter is 96cm high.
- The staff will assist if required.

Outdoor Facilities

- There is a three children's playareas.
- The surface under the play equipment is a mixture of rubber and bark all other areas are grass. The areas are level and are located near the touring facilities with a disabled access shower / toilet and baby changing area. Also near reception and the outdoor pool.
- There are benches in this area.
- The outdoor pool is accessible through 10 steps to an open gates of 1.2m wide and also by another entrance which has 2 steps.
- There is ample sun loungers and chairs on one level.
- The pool has metal steps with non slip pads to access the pool.

The Granary Disco and Amusement Arcade

- The disco and arcade is accessed through doors of a width of 81cm meters. You can gain access by the long walkway ramp which is 139cm wide
- There are raised areas of seating and also areas, which are level.
- Chairs and tables can be moved.
- All areas are non-smoking.
- Some entertainment programmes have strobe lighting effects and loud music - please check with reception.

Holiday Accommodation

- Many statics caravans have 3 steps leading up to the main door with one hand rail.
- They range from a 2 bedroom to 3 bedroom sleeping up to 6 people. Please refer to our brochure or web site for a specific layout of each caravan.
- Parking for caravans is next to each of the holiday caravans. space.
- In 2008 all accommodation is non-smoking.

Local Attractions

- We have a wide variety of information in our reception area and our staff have a vast knowledge of the local area.

Grounds and Gardens

- The park is large and spacious; the distance from the park to the beach at Goodrington sands is approximately 2.6 miles.

- We have been awarded the `Gold` David Bellamy Award.
